Welcome

Parents,

This year is our third consecutive season to offer the Miller Park - Ice Fee Forgiveness Program.

The program has been designed to allow parents the opportunity to off-set their ice fees by participating in this program. By participating in the program, you will earn credit for your ice bill for the 2010-2011 hockey season.

Arrowhead Youth Hockey has entered a contract to provide concession workers during 25 of the Milwaukee Brewers home games. (Based on participation we will have the opportunity to expand the number of games/events that our group participates in). Participants in the Ice Fee Forgiveness Program volunteer for these contracted dates and times.

***Credits have no cash value** – therefore there is no refund or pay-out of earned credits. If you leave the organization or your player does not play the 2010 - 2011 season all credits earned will revert to the organization.

This year we have made some changes to the program. In particular, we have expanded the use of the credits to include the optional Summer Hockey Program that begins in June. Below is some more information on this program.

- * Training is provided at Miller Park for all participants (must be attended)
- * Scheduling is flexible; work the games that work with your schedule.
- * Each shift will last approximately 6 hours.
- * Credits are applied to ice fees only (**this includes the Summer Hockey Program**) Uniforms, equipment, tournament and team fees are not eligible.

Most Commonly Asked Questions:

Q: I attended training last year, do I have to go again?

A: YES - due to the service of alcohol in our stand all participants must attend training each season.

Q: Do I have to pay for parking?

A: NO - you will receive a parking pass for each game you are scheduled to work.

Q: How do I know what games our group is scheduled for?

A: Check the AYHA webpage - under Fund-raising - Miller Park for the most up-to-date schedule

Q: How do I sign up for games?

A: Send your request via email to Tammie Cutre at tcutre@wi.rr.com

Q: Can my husband and I work the same games?

A: We try to accommodate these requests however, there are a limited number of openings per game so it is not always possible.

Q: How much credit will I receive for each game?

A: That depends on how well the group does - the minimum amount of credit that you will receive is \$50 credit to your ice bill.

Q: How will I know my progress?

A: Monthly statements will be sent to your email. Figures are not available until approximately 3 weeks after the last game of the home stand.
